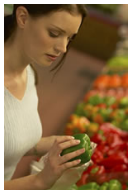
- **Improving Heart Health.** Learn eating habits that can help lower cholesterol, blood pressure and heart disease risk.

COMPUTERIZED DIETARY ANALYSIS

Clients will record food and fluid intake for three consecutive (normal) days and log their exercise. Records will be analyzed using a nutrition software

program. The nutrition summary will provide individualized recommendations based on the client's nutrition and fitness goals. It will also include a list of any nutrients that may be deficient in their diet such as iron, zinc, or B vitamins. In addition, the client will receive a 30-minute consultation.

HEALTHY WEIGHT SUPPORT GROUP

This 60-minute interactive educational group session meets once a week. Participants will learn about topics such as nutrition, physical activity and psychological factors associated with weight management. Build the skills necessary to maintain a healthy weight and support one another in making positive, healthful changes in behavior.
